*The Seaton Hackney Troop Program* provides a forum for individuals to acquire or improve their horsemanship and horseback riding skills in a structured program within a supportive and fun environment. In case of bad weather, Levels 1 & 2 may include a grooming, tacking, safety and handling session as part of the Troop curriculum. Troop is 6 consecutive weeks & Horsemanship 201 is 8 consecutive weeks.

Riders should be able to correctly perform the skills listed under curriculum before moving onto the next level. Instructors may rotate for troops. Detailed level descriptions are available in the office. A personalized assessment of your child's progress will be available either verbally or in writing at the end of Troop. We reserve the right to consolidate or cancel levels. Instructor(s) recommendation, appropriate Badges, riding tests for the upper levels and, in some cases, remedial private lessons will be needed to advance to higher Levels. **IMPORTANT POLICIES**

**1-REFUNDS:** Customers who need to cancel may do so up until one week before the Troop program starts. The Troop Tuition (minus a \$30 administrative fee) may be applied toward any other riding activity at Seaton Hackney Stables. After the program starts, the tuition is no longer refundable **for any reason.**

**2-TRANSFERS / MAKE-UPS:** If a student misses a session, they may make it up by participating in a similar troop session *during the same week* but only with the approval of both the instructors and barn management. In the unlikely event that Seaton Hackney Stables cancels a session, a make-up session will be rescheduled accordingly.

**3-CREDITS:** We cannot credit any missed Troop session, including make-up sessions.

**4-EVALUATIONS:** ALL new riders as well as aspiring level 1A riders must book an evaluation lesson before signing up for Troop. 1A riders must have taken at least 4 private 1/2hr lessons before joining the troop program.
